Police Report




September local report;


This months advice is around home protection and simple concepts to keep it safe. Anti-social Behaviour calls within the Coastal Road area for the months as follows:

- In September there were 8 calls received, with one relating to youth disturbances Acquisitive Crime
- There was one theft reported in the Coastal Road area which is under investigation Drink/Drug Driving
- There were no instances of drink/drug driving in the Coastal Road area Dangerous Driving
- There were no reports of dangerous driving for the month of Septmeber Careless Driving
- There were no reports of careless driving

Stonehaven snapshot – 14 antisocial calls of which 5 related to youth disorders. 5 thefts. 1 drunk/drink driving, 2 dangerous and zero careless driving reported

It was agreed that CKDCC will provide £100 to each school (Catterline and Kinneff) to purchase Christmas Trees.




Planning Applications

Catterline Braes – Storm Babet

- No sign of any movement / slips on the upper slopes
- No damage to harbour road
- As expected, given the duration of the storm, wind/wave direction (east) and tides, quite a lot of material from the unprotected section between the concrete wall and the solid section of cliff (where the gabions used to be prior to 2012) has been lost to sea
- There is also material loss from the other side of the concrete wall, behind the concrete blocks
- Some of the big concrete blocks have been moved by the waves





It was asked if there was any further feedback regarding the SSE plans for pylon route – it was confirmed that SSE had halted there existing plans whilst they carry out further reviews given the feedback from the public consultation that was conducted.
