

# **Community Council Report**

This report covers progress we have made in dealing with your priorities for the Kincardine and Mearns Community Council area for the period November 2022.

The report aims to highlight emerging issues in your area, provide crime prevention advice and guidance to Community Council members and the residents you represent. Our focus is to reduce crime and disorder, help create safer communities and respond effectively to local concerns.

# **Community Policing Priorities**

### Antisocial behaviour, Violence and Disorder:

The amount of Anti-social Behaviour calls within Kincardine and Mearns for November were 12 and in addition to this 10 youth annoyance calls.

The amount of assault calls within Kincardine and Mearns for November were 10.

### **Acquisitive Crime:**

There have been 2 Thefts throughout the Kincardine and Mearns area during November. Both remain undetected and are still being investigated.

# Road Safety & road crime:

### **Drink/Drug Driving**

In November there was 1 driver found to be under the influence of alcohol, who have been reported for consideration of prosecution to the Procurator Fiscal.

In addition there were 2 drivers found to unfit through drugs with one having sufficient evidence to charge and report but the other still under investigation awaiting Laboratory analysis.

### **Dangerous Driving**

In November there was 1 reported incident of dangerous driving which is detected and reported.

### **Careless Driving**

There were 2 reported incidents of careless driving for the month of November both are detected and reported.

# **Community Engagement & Reassurance:**

As discussed and raised at various community council meetings, more precise information has been requested as to area reports.

In the New Year, I hope to narrow it down by dividing K&M into three parts, namely Portlethen, Stonehaven and Laurencekirk, meaning it to be somewhat more personal.

The areas covered historically by the Portlethen, Stonehaven and Laurencekirk Stations will be given separate reports in order that the Community Councils of Laurencekirk area won't be receiving data pertaining to Portlethen etc.

I hope this is welcomed and, once confirmed appropriate by my Command, I will endeavour to begin for January's report.
