Roads and Transport

- Dunnottar Church Road at Glaslaw Bridge to be closed for one day on Monday 15th October.
- Spittal Burn Bridge closed until 4th October
- Proposal for new 747 bus service from Montrose to Peterhead via Kingswells and Airport



Spittal Burn Bridge is now open and it took half the time for the work to be completed.

Abbeyton Bridge options are being reviewed with likely demolition to take place over the festive period. Network Rail to be consulted throughout.

Fixmystreet.com – is monitored by Aberdeenshire Council and is recommended for use in order to resolve all road issues.
