




Defibrillator – Ongoing, update for next meeting.

Gala committee established with sufficient members to continue into 2020.




CKDCC members all agreed that should there be a specific local subgroup, we would attend.




Mill of Uras 5 house application still listed as 'awaiting decision'




ACTION Everyone to review the Local Electricity Bill as sent out on the 26^{th} Nov for discussion at the next meeting




Aberdeenshire Community Planning engage and associate with a lot of groups, seems to match what KDP do in many areas.
