Chief Inspector Kevin Walker taking Local Area Commander role.

- Antisocial Behaviour (25 incidents), Violence and Disorder
  - 8 incidents involving young people with the rest being neighbour disputes and alcohol fuelled behaviours
  - 5 assaults with all of them detected
  - No Serious assaults for March
- Acquisitive Crime
  - 5 thefts in March in which all remain outstanding
  - 4 house break-ins with 2 detected
- Road safety & road crime
  - 2 report of drink driving
  - 1 Incident of dangerous driving report to the PF for consideration
  - 5 incidents of careless driving reported, 2 of which passed to PF
- One ticket issued for breaching lock down rules with positive engagement being provided where appropriate.
