


March updated local report;

Anti-social Behaviour calls within the Coastal Road area for the months as follows:


- March there were 5 calls received, 1 youth disturbances

ACTION Duncan – Forward KDP Hillhead of Auquhirie application and marketing information to CKDCC members as well as for adding to the website.











Key Application Points
