- Road Surface Dressing commencing throughout Aberdeenshire

# Catterline Braes & Operandum



- Continual review of drain efficiency

Plan in the summer to review and potentially move some of the logs that have been affected by the sea erosion (collapsed area). Then use remaining piping for running water away in this section.

Further areas have been identified that are wet and are being further investigated to locate the source.
